

Wildlife (Marine Mammal) Regulations 2009

A marine mammal tour permit is required to conduct whale watching tours or whale swims from a vessel or an aircraft. A permit is also required to conduct tours around protected seal colonies. Permit fees are specified in Regulation 20 of the Wildlife (Marine Mammal) Regulations 2009.
